Vinification

Produced from Aragonez, Alicante Bouschet, Trincadeira and Syrah planted at the Eugénio de Almeida Foundation vineyards. When grapes attain optimum ripeness they are taken to the winery where they undergo a light crush and de-stalking. Fermentation takes place in stainless steel vats between 24-27°C. Maturation is in French and American oak barrels for 4 months and thereafter it is prepared for further aging in bottle.
